The Beaman City Council met at in front of the Beaman Memorial Building on Tuesday, November 7, 2025, for a special emergency council meeting. Mayor Ann Smith called the meeting to order at 5:00 PM. 
The emergency meeting was called to assess damage to the Beaman Memorial Building caused by the demolition of the building located at 209 Main Street. Rubble from the building penetrated the Memorial Building leaving a significant hole in the roof exposing the inside. Boulder Construction, the contractors responsible for tearing down the building, took full responsibility for the damage and have already acted by ordering new truss rafters. They estimate the repairs will be done by Thanksgiving.

Clerk Hoy reported that she had already contacted the city's insurance company agent regarding the incident.
